SUMMER CAMPS AT JONAH MINISTRIES

GENERAL INFORMATION

CHECK-IN (NEW)

Please check your camper packet for check-in information specific to your camp. No early arrivals for registration, please. When you arrive, please drive onto the large field and you will be directed through the registration process. At registration, parents and family are invited to meet your child's counselor, enjoy a free dessert, take a tour of the campus, meet the Camp Director, etc. There is no family BBQ this year. Dinner will be served later to the campers.

CHECK-OUT (NEW)

Please pick up your child on the last day of camp by parking on the field and checking them out at the "Check-out" table in the gym. Photo ID will be required. Please feel free to join us for the last chapel/program in the Mt. Adams Chapel before picking up your camper. Check your camper packet for check-out information specific to your camp. When you arrive to pick up your camper, please park on the field, not in front of the main building.

VISITORS

We are serious about the safety of our campers, and so we discourage all visitation during the camp week. Exceptions will be made only if prearranged, and at the discretion of the Camp Coordinator. All visitors must report to the office upon arrival.

CAMP STORE

Camp T-shirts are available for \$10. Long-sleeved T-shirts are \$15. Sweatshirts are \$25. Candy/popcorn/pop/juice, etc. prices are now \$1 each. Young campers will be allowed only 2 items per day at the Snack Shop. Off-site campers will not have daily access to the Snack Shop.

WHAT TO BRING

Please read the "TO BRING" list in the Theme Camp Packet for items specific to the camp you are attending.

- All paperwork (including waivers and med forms)
- Clothes (enough play clothes for the week), jeans, modest swimsuit, 2 pairs tennis shoes, sweatshirt/coat
- Sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight
- Personal items (toiletries, towel, dirty clothes bag)
- Bible, notebook, pen or pencil

WHAT NOT TO BRING

NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED FOR CAMPERS

Please do not bring the following:

Pets, weapons, any electronics (including cell phones Discman, laptops, iPods, etc.) These items need to be left at home unless permission has been granted prior to arrival at camp.

MEDICATION

All medications brought to camp MUST be checked in at registration. All medications (prescription, supplements, vitamins, etc.) require:

- Original container
- Specific written instructions including name, amount, time, and reason for dispensing
- Parent's signature authorizing administration by camp
- Correct name, time, and dosage on the label for prescription medications

Please send only essential medication. Incidental, over-the-counter medications are supplied by the Medical Supervisor on staff.

REFUND

The \$50 deposit is non-refundable. However, up to two weeks prior to camp, you may transfer your child to a different camp (if available) without penalty. The balance of the camper fee is also due two weeks before the first day of your camp session. A two-week cancellation notice is required in order to receive a refund (minus the deposit).

LOST & FOUND

Please label all belongings. Jonah Ministries is not responsible for lost items. Please keep track of all items sent to camp. It is your responsibility to call and make arrangements for the return of lost items. **All lost and found items will ONLY be kept for two weeks after each camp session.**

DIRECTIONS

Jonah Ministries is 1½ hours from Portland, 1 hour from The Dalles, and 2¼ hours from Yakima.

From Portland:

Follow I-84 East from Portland to Hood River.

Take Exit 64 North across the Columbia River (Bridge Toll is \$0.75).

Turn left at stoplight after crossing the bridge.

Continue West 2 miles, then turn right onto ALT 141 toward Trout Lake.

Continue north 3 miles, then turn left at stop sign onto Hwy. 14.

Travel about 20 miles. After milepost 23, take the first sharp right (immediately past the little red church) onto Little Mountain Road. We're just down this road on the left at 31 Little Mountain Road (in an old school building).

It is helpful to have your balance paid in full **two weeks** before camp starts.
